## THE ASCENSION READING

While staying with them, he ordered them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait there for the promise of the Father. 'This', he said, 'is what you have heard from me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.' So when they had come together, they asked him, 'Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?' He replied, 'It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.' When he had said this, as they were watching, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. While he was going and they were gazing up towards heaven, suddenly two men in white robes stood by them. They said, 'Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up towards heaven? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven.' We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree; but God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear, not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, and who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead. All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.'

You are witnesses of these things. And see, I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.’

Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven. And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy; and they were continually in the temple blessing God.

## THE LITURGY OF INITIATION

¶ *The Bishop addresses the Baptism candidate*

**Bishop** Do you wish to be baptised?

**Catechumen** I do.

¶ *The Bishop addresses the Confirmation candidates who are already baptised.*

**Bishop** Have you been baptised in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit?

**Confirmands** I have.

**Bishop** Are you ready with your own mouth and from your own heart to affirm your faith in Jesus Christ?

**Candidates** I am.

¶ *The Bishop addresses the congregation.*

**Bishop** Faith is the gift of God to his people. In baptism the Lord is adding to our number those whom he is calling. People of God, will you welcome these candidates and uphold them in their life in Christ?

**With the help of God, we will.**

# THE DECISION

**Bishop** In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him. Therefore I ask:

Do you reject the devil and all rebellion against God?

**Candidates** I reject them.

**Bishop** Do you renounce the deceit and corruption of evil?

**Candidates** I renounce them.

**Bishop** Do you repent of the sins that separate us from God and neighbour?

**Candidates** I repent of them.

**Bishop** Do you turn to Christ as Saviour?

**Candidates** I turn to Christ.

**Bishop** Do you submit to Christ as Lord?

**Candidates** I submit to Christ.

**Bishop** Do you come to Christ, the way, the truth and the life?

**Candidates** I come to Christ.

¶ *The Bishop signs the forehead of the catechumen*

**Bishop** Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross.

**Bishop** Do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

**All** **Fight valiantly as a disciple of Christ against sin, the world and the devil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.**

**Bishop** May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, restore in you the image of his glory, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ.

¶ *As the Bishop and candidates move to the font, all stand to sing:*

**Holy Spirit, come, confirm us  
in the truth that Christ makes known;  
We have faith and understanding  
through your helping gifts alone.**

**Bishop** Praise God who made heaven and earth.

**All** **Who keeps his promise forever.**

**Bishop** Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**Bishop** Almighty God, whose Son Jesus Christ was baptised in the river Jordan, we thank you for the gift of water to cleanse us and revive us.

We thank you that through the waters of the Red Sea you led your people out of slavery to freedom in the Promised Land.

We thank you that through the deep waters of death  
you brought your Son,  
and raised him to life in triumph.

Bless this water, that your servants who are washed in it  
may be made one with Christ in his death and in his  
resurrection,  
to be cleansed and delivered from all sin.  
Send your Holy Spirit upon them,  
bring them to new birth in the household of faith  
and raise them with Christ to full and eternal life;  
for all might, majesty, authority and power are yours,  
now and for ever.

## THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

**Bishop** Brothers and sisters, I ask you all to join with these candidates  
in professing the faith of the Church.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father?

Do you believe and trust in God the Son?

**All**     **I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,  
born of the Virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried;  
he descended to the dead.**

**On the third day he rose again;  
he ascended into heaven,  
he is seated at the right hand of the Father,  
and he will come to judge the living and the dead.**

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit?

**All** I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic Church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting.  
Amen.

**Bishop** N, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son,  
and of the Holy Spirit.

**All** Amen.

*¶ The Bishop sprinkles the other candidates and then  
the congregation with water from the font as we sing:*

## CONFIRMATION

¶ *The congregation sits.*

**Bishop** Our help is in the name of the Lord.

**All** **Who has made heaven and earth.**

**Bishop** Blessed be the name of the Lord.

**All** **Now and forever. Amen.**

¶ *The Bishop extends her hands towards those to be confirmed and says*

**Bishop** Almighty and ever-living God,  
you have given these your servants new birth  
in baptism by water and the Spirit,  
and have forgiven them all their sins.  
Let your Holy Spirit rest upon them:  
the Spirit of wisdom and understanding;  
the Spirit of counsel and inward strength;  
the Spirit of knowledge and true godliness;  
and let their delight be in the fear of the Lord.

**All** **Amen.**

¶ *As each candidate comes forward the Bishop addresses them by name and anoints them with holy oil*

**Bishop** N, God has called you by name and made you his own.

¶ *She then lays her hand on the head of each, saying*

**Bishop** Confirm, O Lord, your servant with your Holy Spirit.

**All** Amen.

¶ *Once all have been confirmed, they turn to face the congregation and the Bishop invites the congregation to pray for them*

**All** Defend, O Lord, these your servants with your heavenly grace, that they may continue yours for ever, and daily increase in your Holy Spirit more and more until they come to your everlasting kingdom.  
**Amen.**

¶ *The newly confirmed turn back to face the Bishop. All stand.*

## THE PEACE
